While there is an ongoing discussion about internationalization more often than not, the focus is centered around the internationalization of learning, instead of the discourse itself. At the same time, most information provided as well as the courses available online lack references with respect to the internationalization of firms and professional accounts.

4EXPORT project, running up until September of 2021, seeks to specialize in interdisciplinary apprenticeship education and the development of cross-border policy dialogues with regards to the mismatch of labor skillsets and industry needs. Among the target group to be addressed; VET educators, in-company tutors, trainers and potential trainers, SMEs, and students.

The project consortium consists of Ireland, Poland, Italy, and Spain represented by CCSDE, E.RI.FO, CWEP and Fyg. The project team already held the kick-off meeting in Spain to go through the project objectives and the allocation of proposed activities. Primarily, the core team aspires to develop a complete curriculum for in-company tutors and also, design an interactive web platform featuring case studies with best practices from the participating countries accessible to the public. Last but not least, the team will also bring together a self-directed learning guide on internationalization activities for in-job trainings available in all national languages of the participating countries.

The next transnational meeting will be held in Poland in June to follow up the dissemination activities and the overall project timeline.
