WILL COVID-19 HAVE A LASTING IMPACT ON GLOBALIZATION?

The situation due to the Covid-19 pandemic posed questions such as where would commerce survive and how to manage the supply chains; along with a situation of uncertainty around the precise economic impact. The national and international sectors have been shut down which makes the forecasting of finances rather uncertain, especially given the persistence of the virus and its impact.

WTO economists argue that the decline will likely exceed the trade slump brought on by the global financial crisis of 2008-09 with a fall by between 13% and 32% in 2020 in world trade.
